Prior to 1990 the Dominican Republic was well known for its filler and binder tobacco. Growing wrapper tobacco on the island proved impossible due to the topography of the land and the wind. Carlos Fuente Jr. set out on a mission to be the first cigar maker in the Dominican Republic to successfully grow wrapper tobacco. With the help of cheesecloths to protect the tobacco from the elements, the first successful crop was turned out in 1992. This wrapper is matched with unparalleled vintage tobaccos for its filler and binder and was the first Dominican puro (all Dominican cigar) on the market.*
