The Ashton Cabinet includes no less than six different tobaccos and ends with a "big finish." Seven years pass from seedling to finished cigar before Ashton Cabinet is brought to fruition.*

## **MACANUDO 2000, CHURCHILL**

*The Macanudo Vintage possesses a silky, blond Connecticut wrapper from the 2000 crop. This cigar is perfect for those aficionados looking for something vintage, smooth and mild. Very few crops have a quality that designates them as vintage worthy. However, in 2000 the Connecticut Valley saw one of its finest crops this century and General Cigar, the makers of Macanudo, had the foresight to put a great deal of this leaf away for extra aging. Prior to this debut, Macanudo has only released 5 editions of the Vintage line since 1979.*

## **FUENTE, OPUS X**

*Perhaps the most rare and highest rated brand in the world, these cigars have a world-renowned reputation for quality and class. They are full-bodied with a rich, robust flavor and are some of the rarest cigars in the world. It is elusive to almost every smoker because of its limited production. Prior to 1990 the Dominican Republic was well know for its filler and binder tobacco. Growing wrapper tobacco on the island proved impossible due to the topography of the land and the wind. The wrapper is a vital component of any cigar as it contributes to most of the flavor. Carlos Fuente Jr. set out on a mission to be the first cigar maker in the Dominican Republic to successfully grow wrapper tobacco. With the help of cheesecloths to protect the tobacco from the elements, the first successful crop was turned out in 1992. This wrapper is matched with unparalleled vintage tobaccos for its filler and binder and was the first Dominican puro (all Dominican cigar) on the market.*
