Marríage

Requirements

Palm Beach County Clerk of the Circuit Court

You do not have to be a resident of Florida to apply for a marriage license; however, both parties must be present when applying. One of the following forms of identification is required for each party to obtain a marriage license.

- Driver's license issued in the United States;
- Federal or state identification card; or
- Passport showing your name and date of birth

Birth certificates or green cards are not acceptable. A blood test is not required.

If either party was married before, the manner in which the last marriage ended and the exact date the marriage ended are required. Copies of the death certificate or Final Decree of Divorce, Dissolution or Annulment are not required.

The cost of a license is \$86.00. The mandatory three-day waiting period for Florida residents may be waived if the couple attends a premarital course from a registered provider and presents a certificate of completion when applying for a license. There is no waiting period for non-Florida residents. A directory of the premarital course providers is available at all court locations.

Additionally, both residents and non-residents of Florida may receive a \$25.00 discount on their marriage license by completing a premarital course. The course must be completed no more than one year prior to the date of application for a marriage license. Both parties must attend the course and, once again, a certificate of completion must be presented at the time of application to be eligible for the discount.

The Circuit Civil Department takes applications for and issues marriage licenses as well as performs ceremonies. A fee of \$30.00 is required for the Clerk to perform a Ceremony. The Clerk accepts cash, check and money orders.

A marriage license is valid in any county in the State of Florida. It is valid for 60 days and no extensions may be made.
